Triumphant Church's desire is to serve the North Carolina Central University (NCCU) campus community by helping to meet the needs of the student body.

In 1996, NCCU was the first college in North Carolina and one of the first Historically Black Colleges or Universities (HBCUs) in the nation to implement a community engagement requirement. In keeping with NCCU's motto of "Truth and Service," undergraduate students must complete 15 hours per semester of community-engaged or community-based service prior to graduation (120 total hours).

As of December 2022, Triumphant became registered as an Approved Partner registered with the NCCU's Office of Community Engagement and Service (OCES).
